# Heritage Pointe Rules & Regulations

1. If Alcohol is SERVED there must be a Police Officer in attendance at the event (at least one officer per 50-75 people). The attending Police Officer must have prior approval from the Dillsboro Police Chief. Payment for the Police Office is the responsibility of the Reservation Applicant. If Alcohol is SERVED, you are required to have a Licensed Bar Tender serving the alcohol. Reminder: if individuals bring their own Alcohol, it is to be consumed responsibly and according to State Law.
2. Absolutely NO glass bottles or containers of any kind allowed in the Park.
3. All trash must be picked up and placed in appropriate receptacles.
4. Absolutely NO overnights or camping is permitted.
5. For evening functions all music and loud noise must cease by 10:00.
6. Any damages that occur will be the responsibility of the designated person responsible for the event.
7. Smoking is allowed in designated areas only. Receptacles are provided.
8. Absolutely NO FIREWORKS of any type are permitted on Town property.
9. The Town of Dillsboro is to be Held Harmless from ALL damages and injuries.
10. Grilling or deep-frying must be no less than 10ft from any building.
11. Remove all animal waste.
12. All pets must be on a 6' leash.
13. Be respectful of the landscaping and do not move any stones.
