Request for Proposals (RFP)

Residential Solid Waste and Recycling Collection Services

Issue Date: April 20, 2026 (revised 05/15/2026)

Proposal Due Date: 2:00 PM, May 20, 2026

1. INTRODUCTION

The Town of Dillsboro, Indiana ("Town") is seeking sealed proposals from qualified firms for:

- The collection and disposal of 542 residential solid waste and recyclable materials within the Town limits. Services shall include weekly curbside solid waste collection, bi-weekly curbside recycling collection, and
- The provision and servicing of a 30-yard dumpster at the Town's Wastewater Treatment Plant, and
- The provision and servicing of a 6-yard dumpster at the Dillsboro Community Park from approximately April 15th through October 31st
- The provision and servicing of a 30-yard dumpster during the Homecoming Fair, approximately May 15th.
- Alternate Bid Items. The following items should be provided as an optional alternate bid:
 - Business account dumpster service to include a monthly fee for weekly dumpster service. Proposal should include the cost of dumpster by size options willing to be offered. Currently there are 23 commercial customers within the town incorporated boundary (3 of which are apartment complexes).
 - Quarterly curbside heavy trash pickup for town residential properties.

The Town's current three-year contract expires on July 31, 2026. The Town intends to award a contract in advance to ensure continuity of service.

2. PROCUREMENT TIMELINE

- RFP Issued: April 20, 2026
- Deadline for Questions: May 8, 2026
- Proposals Due: May 20, 2026 (ahead of the **June 8**, 2026 Town Council meeting)
- Evaluation Period: May 20-May 29, 2026
- Preferred Contract Award Date: June 8, 2026 (regular Town Council meeting)
- Final Contract Execution Deadline: July 13, 2026 (regular Town Council meeting)
- Service Start Date: August 1, 2026



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The Town anticipates selecting a preferred proposer as early as its June 8, 2026 meeting and entering into contract negotiations thereafter. Final contract execution is anticipated no later than July 13, 2026.

3. SCOPE OF SERVICES

3.1 Residential Units

The Town currently has approximately 542 residential customers receiving curbside collection.

3.2 Required Collection Services

Respondents shall provide the following minimum services:

A. Weekly Solid Waste Collection

- Weekly curbside collection of bagged and containerized household trash.
- Collection from private residence-owned cans shall be permitted.
- Indicate whether vendor-provided cans are available, mandatory, or optional, including associated costs.

B. Bi-Weekly Recycling Collection

- Bi-weekly curbside collection of recyclables.
- Indicate acceptable recyclable materials and any preparation requirements.
- Indicate whether recycling carts are provided by the vendor.

C. 30-Yard Dumpster Service

- Provide and maintain one (1) 30-yard roll-off dumpster located at:
Dillsboro Wastewater Treatment Plant

- Removal and replacement shall be on-demand, when notified by Town personnel.
- Average anticipated haul frequency: once per month.
- Required response/removal time: within 3 business days of notification.

D. 6-Yard Dumpster Service

- Provide and maintain one (1) 6-yard roll-off dumpster located at:
Dillsboro Community Park

Dillsboro, IN 47018
- Removal and replacement shall be once per month from April through October.
- Dumpster must be capable of being locked and sealed.

E. Temporary 30-Yard Dumpster Service



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- Provide and maintain one (1) 30-yard roll-off dumpster located at:
Dillsboro Town Shop
10107 Western Row
Dillsboro, IN 47018
- Placement and removal shall occur once annually from the middle of May until requested to be disposed of, approximately 2 weeks.

3.3 Optional / Alternate Services (Alternate Bids)

Respondents shall provide separate pricing for:

1. Business account dumpster service to include a monthly fee for weekly dumpster service. Proposal should include the cost of dumpster by size options willing to be offered.
2. Periodic heavy trash/bulk item pickup (describe acceptable items, frequency, and scheduling process). Proposal shall include a quarterly curbside heavy pickup option for residential customers. The town is open to alternative delivery methods as the contractor's suggestions, such as, price per pickup, billed directly to residents or service provided based on a fee built into monthly service.
3. Three-year contract term (base bid).
4. Five-year contract term (alternate bid).

4. CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBILITIES

The selected contractor shall:

- Furnish all labor, equipment, materials, trucks, carts, and containers necessary for service provision.
- Maintain vehicles in clean and safe working order, clearly marked with company identification.
- Ensure all personnel are trained, licensed, and identifiable.
- Provide customer service contact information and a complaint/issue resolution procedure.
- Comply with all applicable federal, state, and local regulations governing municipal solid waste and recycling, including but not limited to Indiana Code Title 36 and all rules of the Indiana Department of Environmental Management governing solid waste collection, transportation, and disposal.
- The Contractor shall ensure that all solid waste collected under this contract is transported in accordance with applicable provisions of 329 IAC 11 and delivered only to facilities permitted and authorized to accept such waste.
- Maintain insurance coverage meeting Indiana municipal contract requirements (general liability, auto liability, workers compensation, etc.).



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- Provide monthly reports including tonnage of solid waste and recyclables collected.

5. TOWN RESPONSIBILITIES

The Town of Dillsboro will:

- Provide and maintain a list of residential units to be serviced.
- Provide public information regarding service expectations and any changes.
- Designate authorized staff to coordinate dumpster removal and service concerns.

6. PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS

Proposals shall include, at minimum, the following information:

1. Company Overview
 - Legal name, address, point of contact, years in operation.
 - Description of company experience with municipal solid waste collection.
2. Service Plan
 - Proposed collection schedule.
 - Description of equipment to be used.
 - Description of recycling program.
 - Response time commitments (including the required 3-business-day roll-off removal time).
3. Container Information
 - Whether trash or recycling carts are provided.
 - Options and pricing for Town-wide uniform carts.
 - Policies for servicing resident-owned cans.
4. Pricing Proposal
 - Per-residence rate for weekly solid waste service.
 - Per-residence rate for bi-weekly recycling service.
 - Per pull and per-ton pricing for 30-yard dumpster haul.
 - Cost structure for optional heavy trash pickup.
 - Alternate pricing for three-year and five-year contract terms.
5. Compliance and Safety
 - Proof of insurance.
 - A statement certifying compliance with all applicable IDEM regulations and Indiana law governing solid waste transportation and disposal.
 - Identification of all disposal and processing facilities proposed to be used, including facility name and location.
 - Description of collection vehicles and equipment



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- USDOT number (if applicable) and any other relevant operating registrations.
- Description of the company's safety program and spill response procedures.

6. References

- Contact information for at least three (3) municipal customers have served within the past five (5) years.

Proposals remain valid for a minimum of 120 days from the submission deadline.

7. EVALUATION CRITERIA

Proposals will be evaluated on the basis of:

- Cost and competitiveness.
- Contractor experience and qualifications.
- Ability to meet required service levels.
- Approach to recycling and waste reduction.
- Availability and quality of equipment and containers.
- Responsiveness to Town needs, including response times.
- References and past performance.

The Town reserves the right to request additional documentation demonstrating compliance with applicable environmental and transportation regulations prior to contract award and to reject any or all proposals, waive minor informalities, and negotiate with the preferred proposer.

8. CONTRACT TERM

The Town anticipates entering into a three-year contract, with an optional five-year alternate, beginning August 1, 2026, immediately following expiration of the current contract.

Project Description:

The Town is soliciting proposals from qualified contractors to provide weekly curbside solid waste collection, bi-weekly recycling collection, and related dumpster services for approximately 542 residential customers within the Town limits, along with certain optional services as further described in the Request for Proposals (RFP).

The Town reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, waive informalities, and negotiate with the selected proposer. All proposals shall remain valid for a period of 120 days.



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Question & Answer

Q1: What rate are you paying now for trash and recycling per residence?

A1: \$13.23 per unit per month for weekly curbside trash pickup; \$4.50 per unit per month for every other week curbside recycling.

Q2: The 23 commercial accounts are they separate now from the current contract?

A2: Yes. Commercial accounts are not included in the Town's current contract, each business contracts directly for service. The Town is considering an option to include these accounts under the municipal contract to leverage collective pricing. This is presented as an alternate bid item and may or may not be selected.

Q3: What are you currently paying for the 6-yard and 30-yards?

A3: \$551.25 per load and \$41.90 per ton for a 30-yard container; \$81.44 per month for weekly service.

Q4: What day is trash being serviced on now for the residents?

A4: Trash collection takes place on Thursdays.

Q5: What day is recycling serviced on

A5: Recycling collection takes place every other Thursday. The first one in the 2026 calendar year fell on January 8th.

Q6: Do you know how many people recycle?

A6: That data is not readily available, I'd guess somewhere between 50-75% of our customer base.

Q7.1: Is it your intention for haulers to only provide a -3-year firm/fixed rate? You only have 1-line on bid forms for 3-year and 5-year rates without any lines so we can offer a year 1 rate, along with year 2 rate, and year 3 rate etc... Rumpke has previously always offered rate adjustments annually.



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Q7.2: So pricing will remain the same for a 3-year period and then a 5-year period?

A7: No, it is not the Town's intention to require a strictly fixed 3-year rate. The original format was intended to simplify comparisons across proposals; however, the Town recognizes that annual rate adjustments are standard industry practice. The bid form will be revised to allow respondents to provide annual pricing for Years 1 through 5, with Years 4 and 5 identified as optional extensions. This will allow for a more transparent and equitable comparison of proposals while accommodating typical pricing structures.

Q8: Are you looking for a monthly rate for all 542 homes to be provided with a 95-gallon trash cart that is included with our rate as an alternate? This would be an additional bid rate than a normal rate that would allow us to rent trash carts to any residents upon request for an additional fee. You only have a section on the bid forms for written description or check mark of yes/no/optional. This leaves it open for not comparing apples to apples from multiple haulers bidding.

A8: The Town's preference is to avoid requiring residents to separately purchase or rent carts, but we are open to evaluating proposals that include such a cart provision if they are cost-effective and operationally beneficial. To ensure an apples-to-apples comparison, the bid forms will be revised to request the following:

- A base service rate without carts (if applicable), and
- An alternate rate that includes provision of 95-gallon carts for all residential customers, clearly indicating whether costs are embedded or itemized.

Respondents are also encouraged to outline their recommended service model and billing structure, including whether carts are Town-owned, contractor-owned, or customer-leased, and how those costs would be billed (e.g., direct to Town vs. pass-through to customers).

Q9: What is the intent on the 23 commercial dumpster containers being included, and how did you come up with 23? Does the Town want to be billed by the awarded hauler directly on these? Do you have an address list on these and sizes? Are these currently with dumpsters and likely contracted directly with Rumpke or other haulers? Rumpke and other haulers have signed contractual agreements with businesses directly.

A9: At present, commercial customers are not included in the Town's solid waste billing structure, with limited exceptions where some businesses receive residential-



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type service. The inclusion of approximately 23 commercial accounts is exploratory and intended to:

- Assess whether incorporating commercial service could expand the service base,
- Potentially improve pricing and service consistency, and
- Provide added value to both haulers and local businesses.

The Town can provide a list of commercial locations prior to final proposal submission. Container sizes and service details may be limited; therefore, respondents are encouraged to propose standardized service options (e.g., dumpster sizes, pickup frequencies, and associated pricing tiers) that businesses could select from. The Town’s preliminary concept is for the hauler to bill the Town, with the Town subsequently billing the commercial customers. However, the Town acknowledges that:

- Existing private contracts may be in place, and
- Participation by commercial customers may need to be voluntary or phased.

This portion of the RFP is intended to gather information and options, and the Town reserves the right to include, modify, or exclude commercial services based on feasibility and stakeholder input.

Q11: An IDEM compliance safety permit no longer exists, only have a valid IDEM Haulers Permit.

A11: The RFP has been amended to clarify that only a valid IDEM Hauler's Permit is required.

Q12: The carts that are in the town now, does Rumpke charge the resident or the town?

A12: Rumpke charges the town monthly, the town bills the residents monthly. For the Rumpke cans, those were an optional add that residents could choose to purchase or lease from Rumpke.

Q13: Would the city like to see uniform carts for both trash and recycle.



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A13: At this time there is no preference from the Town. It is presumed that there may be some operational efficiencies by requiring uniform carts. If this is the case, the bidder should include this information in their proposal and note upfront cost and reoccurring cost on the bid sheet.

Q14: Do you pay a fuel surcharge now?

A14: No, a fuel surcharge is not in place, the contract is per unit based on the customer count.

Q15: Have the commercial accounts been informed of the possible change?

A15: All commercial accounts have received notice and have been asked to contact the Town Manager with questions and comments and notified of the Council meeting dates when action is anticipated to be taken.
