Dillsboro's potential lies in its proximity to major transportation hubs and logistically near to a variety of workforce training centers. The community is located on US Highway 50, 1.5 miles south of the CSX railroad and 28 miles from the Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky International Airport .

This small town is home to 1401 residents. Dillsboro provides a variety of amenities to its residents: library, parks, trails, greenspaces, arts and cultural center, and the finest of upgraded utilities including internet and cell service by all major providers.

The town's safety is assured by two fulltime police officers and a canine unit. In 2015, Dillsboro was ranked as one of the safest communities in the tristate by *Cincy Magazine*.

Heritage Pointe and The Porch at Friendship Gallery are the focal area in downtown Dillsboro. It features an outdoor cultural venue for performing arts with beautiful landscaping and outdoor furniture. Several annual events are held here; a Veteran's Day program, The Dillsboro Farmers Market, "Our Hometown Christmas", Dillsboro in Bloom and a place of respite during the annual Homecoming Festival.



**Dillsboro** is governed by a five member Town Council. In addition, a Town Manager, Clerk/Treasurer, Economic Development Director and Utilities Staff are available to meet all of the community needs.

The Town Council meets on the 2nd and 4th Monday of each month at the Town Hall at 6:30 PM. The voices and concerns of the community are always welcome.



**Emergency Services** are provided to the town of Dillsboro by the volunteer EMS. The Dillsboro Life Squad is led by Co-Captain Bev Tackitt and Joey Addison. The Squad is located at 13036 North Street. Volunteers respond to over 300 emergencies each year including car accidents, back-up to fire calls, and assist other community ambulance services. They also provide first-aid at local events



The **Dillsboro Volunteer Fire Department** is the town's other emergency response organization. Fire Chief Tim Heitmeyer leads the dedicated volunteers who respond to fires, auto accidents, farm accidents and hazardous materials accidents. The Department is certified by the Indiana Emergency Medical Commission as a Basic Support Emergency Medical Provider and assists the local life squads on first response as needed.



Dillsboro has a **Community Park**. It includes four baseball fields, three soccer fields, 2 playgrounds, several shelters, picnic tables and restroom facilities. The park is surrounded by a beautiful tree landscaped walking trail. Park facilities are open to the public and may be reserved for special events, reunions, receptions and picnics.

Dillsboro Arts Friendship Gallery: A place for artful conversation... is the cultural center of Dillsboro. Dillsboror Arts is open Tuesdays 6-8, Thursdays 4-6, and Saturdays 10-2. The Writers' Group meets first and third Tuesdays 6-8 and Musicians'

Circle second and fourth Tuesdays 6-8.



The Dillsboro Library is a branch of the Aurora Public Library District. It serves the town of Dillsboro, and Clay, and Caesar Creek Townships. It is also home to the Dillsboro Historical Room. In 2019, our library was the first Hoosier community selected to host the Smithsonian Exhibit, "Crossroads: Change in Rural America"
